

Fire Evacuation procedures for Galloway Cricket Club House

In the event of a fire at the Club House it is essential that the occupants are evacuated to the cricket ground well clear of the Club house, if safe to do so all changing rooms and toilets are to me checked, a roll taken and the Fire Service contacted.

If the fire occurs on a match day is the responsibility of the home captain or their nominee to:

- To ensure that the building is evacuated
- Changing rooms showers and toilets checked (only if safe to do so)
- A roll taken and that the Fire Service contacted.

Should a fire occur when the club house is being used for purposes such as being hired out or a meeting it is the responsibility of the hirer, meeting leader etc:

- To ensure that the building is evacuated
- Changing rooms, showers and toilets checked (only if safe to do so)
- A roll taken and that the Fire Service contacted.
